Financing social initiatives and businesses – Opportunities in programming period 2021-2027

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Social economy in EU

- 2 million social economy enterprises in Europe, representing 10% of all businesses in the EU.
- About 6% of the EU's employees work for social economy enterprises.
- Social economy contributes about 8 % to the EU GDP.
- They operate a very broad number of commercial activities and provide a wide range of products and services.
- Different legal forms of subjects, such as cooperatives, associations, social enterprises and alike.





Action plan for social economy

- European commission is preparing Action plan for social economy.
- The publication of the plan is foreseen in December 2021.
- The plan will be a key tool for systematical incorporation of social economy into the different socio-economic policies of the EU.
- It will also incorporate actions to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals.
- Proposed duration of the plan is 5 years (2021-2026).





Cohesion Policy 2021-2027

- EU Cohesion Policy contributes to strengthening economic, social and territorial cohesion in EU.
- It aims to correct imbalances between countries and regions.
- It delivers on EU's political priorities, especially the green and digital transition.
- EU Cohesion Policy supports activities devoted to promotion and enforcement of social economy, especially social innovation.





Social economy in Slovenia

- Social economy in Slovenia is defined by the Social Entrepreneurship Act.
- Main objectives of the Social Entrepreneurship Act:
 - 1. Introduction of the concept social economy & social entrepreneurship.
 - 2. Definition of aims and principles of social entrepreneurship.
 - 3. Defining the criteria for obtaining social enterprise status.
 - 4. Defining the ways of promoting social entrepreneurship.
 - 5. Defining the jurisdiction on the field of social economy and the strategic development of the sector.





Social enterprises in Slovenia

- First social enterprise registered in Slovenia:13. 3. 2012.
- In 2021 272 social enterprises are registered (66 legal subjects abolished or lost the status of social enterprise since 2012).
- Social economy sector on the other hand employ a higher share of the active population (0.268%) with revenues that represent 0.269% of GDP.
- Social enterprises employ a small share of the active Slovenian, population (0.045%) and their revenues represent 0.041% of GDP.

Main achievements of the ministry

- Integration of the social economy into programming documents of European cohesion policy in period 2014 – 2020 and 2021 – 2027 and other instruments such as and ReactEU.
- Modification of the Law on Public procurement retained public procurement for social enterprises.
- Modification of the Physical Assets of the State and Local Government Act – non profit rents/usage of real state for social enterprises.
- Social enterprises are included as a target group/ applicants on all public tenders of the ministry where it is legally possible.
- Social enterprises that have obtained the public interest status for NGO can get donations from income tax.





Main challenges

- Preparation of the national Strategy of development of social economy 2021-2031.
- Preparation of national system for Social impact measurement.
- Enhancement of social innovations in the sector of social economy.





Business support for social enterprises

- Formal specialized business support for social enterprises public tender in progress.
- SPOT: Expert business support for future and established business and social economy subjects concerning registrations, electronic operations, business consulting and provision of information.
- SIO (Platform for innovative business): Platform unites incubators, university incubators, technologic centers etc. and provides free promotion, motivation and professional support.
- Growing (informal), autonomous business support for social enterprises





Cohesion Policy 2014-2020 in Slovenia + ReactEU

- Vouchers for digitalization for SMEs and registered social enterprises – digital marketing, digital competences (SPS).
- Mentorship schemes for social enterprises (SRRS).





Financial instruments

- Financial instruments available also to social enterprises, especially FI Microloans for SMEs.
- 5 mio EUR estimated to be delivered to social enterprises. (SIB, SPS)
- Microloans for SMEs: 5.000 to 25.000 EUR.
- Eligible costs: investments and working capital.
- Maturity: 2 to 5 years.
- Grace period: up to $\frac{1}{2}$ maturity.
- Co-financing rate: up to 85%.





Cohesion Policy 2021-2027 in Slovenia

- Operative program and partnership agreement work in progress.
- Social economy is suggested to be part of two main objective of OP:
 - 1. Smarter EU innovative transformation of the economy: Social innovation & Silver economy (11 mio).
 - 2. Knowledge, competences and skills for the future: Professionalization od social economy and (business) support ecosystem (10 mio).





Other measures to support the development of social enterprises

- Promoting social economy and social entrepreneurship in border areas.
- SIB (Social investment bonds).
- OECD collaboration.
